This policy has been developed to provide appropriate, consistent, and cost-effective use of the Glendale Avenue Yard Waste Site. This site is available for residents, not contractors or commercial properties.

### I. CITY OF APPLETON RESIDENTS MAY DROP OFF:

Leaves, brush, grass, metal, batteries, antifreeze, motor oil, tires, appliances, and overflow garbage/bulky curbside recycling items.

### II. TOWN OF GRAND CHUTE RESIDENTS MAY DROP OFF:

Leaves, brush, and grass. and motor oil.

### **III.** OUTAGAMIE COUNTY RESIDENTS MAY DROP OFF:

Motor oil.

A. Freon appliances

B. Non-freon appliances

C. Tires (no rims)

D. Grass

## **Y.IV.** REGULATIONS:

- **A.** All customers shall be carded for provide proof of residency.
- B. Building materials, yard waste, gGarbage and overflow items are not accepted from contractors.
- C. Dirt, root balls, stumps, and sod are not accepted.
- D. Skids and wood lumber are not accepted go on wood pile.
- E. Sand, gravel and concrete are not accepted.
- F. Treated wood products are considered overflow garbage.
- G.F. Electronics and hazardous waste are not accepted.
- **H.G.** Shingles are not accepted.
- **L.H.** Oil filters are not accepted.

#### VI. COMMITMENT

Attempt will be made to have appropriate amount of containers on site for overflow purposes, but no guarantee based on space and staffing constraints.
