*The Appleton Area School District (AASD) Attendance Team appreciates the amendment to the amendment to the original resolution submitted during the September 10th meeting of the Safety and Licensing Committee. However, we are going to ask the Committee to reconsider one additional disposition. We believe there is value in disposition (J), but we will certainly be fine with the five that were included in the second amendment. In addition, under bullet point #5 of the second amendment, the first two bullet points cannot be disclosed as they are confidential student records. In the attached document, we provide alternative language that should provide council members with the desired information in a non-confidential manner.*

*Several AASD Board members have attended the Safety and Licensing Committee meetings over the past five months, including the September 10th meeting when six of our seven Board members were in attendance. Having heard concerns from S & L Committee members about AASD procedures continuing to be supportive and that if an ordinance is passed it will only be used as a last resort, our Board will add language to our current attendance policy and operational expectations. By doing so, our Board of Education can ensure that the current level of support for students will not decrease, and a citation will always be a last resort. The second attachment to this email includes the language for the policy addition on the front side and the operational expectations on the back side.*
