In my role as the Controller, I am a key member of the Administration management team and responsible for analyzing all aspects of county finances and providing advice, recommendations and options to the Director of Administration, management and staff in other county departments.

As the Assistant Finance Director, I manage, supervise, and lead 18 Finance Department Staff members to achieve goals within available resources; plan and organize workloads and staff assignments; train, motivate and evaluate staff; review progress and direct changes as needed. Monitors performance goals with the department staff.

I manage multimillion dollar cash portfolio and report monthly performance to Council Members, maintain Treasury Management relationships with Banking and Investment partners, and prepare, review and distribute the Annual Trust report.

I am responsible for the preparation, review, and distribution of the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR), review and distribute Single Audit, maintain various cash, debt, and fixed asset schedules for footnotes in financial reports, and prepare, review and file various state required reports related to financial statements. In addition, I am responsible for preparing and filing the State annual reports pertaining to established Tax Incremental Districts and update various Tax Incremental District spreadsheets to include cash flow projections.

I act as strategic partner with our external audit firm to prepare, assist, and finalize the annual audit. The duties to aid in this partnership include maintaining 78 funds of which, 65 are Governmental funds, 13 Proprietary funds (9 Enterprise and four Internal Service) in the general ledger. Monthly general ledger reconciliations are prepared and reviewed.

On a monthly basis I conduct the monthly financial closing, inventory counts, account reconciliations and reporting to the Senior Management and Board of Directors. On a weekly/daily basis a recap of Sales and Production report is prepared and submitted to Senior Management, Cash Forecasting, reconciliation of Cash Receipts, and support other general ledger functions such as Payroll, Accounts Payable, Accounts Receivable, inter-company transactions, fixed assets and consolidations while adhering the US GAAP and internal control requirements.

In the accounting/treasury function for the Town, I maintain all financial management systems to include Operating Budgets, Debt Structure, and records of the Town in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Overall responsibilities include designing and implementing procedures to establish an effective system of internal controls over accounting and financial reporting, plan and organizes complex financial projects, recommends and participates in the development of finance related goals, objectives, and policies, advises the Town Board other department managers concerning strategic financial matters of importance to the Town, work collaboratively with other Town staff to solve financial operation matters, and supervises the development and implementation of the automated financial system.

Daily responsibilities include completion of all aspects of bi-weekly payroll, quarterly reports, and year-end closing procedures, maintaining monthly financial records to ensure all funds are in balance with budget and complete journal entries as required. Compile, review, analyze, and prepare the annual Town budget including revenue projections and budget estimates. Other responsibilities include reconciling monthly bank statements, investments, and annual tax roll. Manage annual tax collection process in cooperation with the County Treasurer including mailing bills, giving tax information to the public, receipting bills, reconciling information forwarded to and received from the County Treasurer, monitoring reports returned from the county and disbursing proper funds to state, county, and school districts from tax collections in accordance with state law. Prepare monthly treasurer's report to the Town Board, Utility Board, Park Board and Fire Department.

In addition, I oversee a staff of 15 and manage the financial aspects for the Utility Department. Duties include debt service analysis, revenue projections, population growth forecasting, produce quarterly billings, and reconcile utility funds monthly.
