On December 13, 2013, Wisconsin State Assembly Bill 169 was enacted, which adds commercial quadricycles to the list of unlicensed public places where fermented malt beverages may be consumed,

Whereas

The bill also authorizes a municipality to prohibit the consumption of fermented malt beverages on commercial quadricycles, but a municipality may not enforce such a prohibition in a previously existing ordinance,

Be it Resolved

That the City of Appleton adopt an ordinance prohibiting the consumption of fermented malt beverages on commercial quadricycles."
