Whereas, we are planning to add in the next 3-10 years: The Trolley Trestle Trail from Atlas Mill to Pullmans, Lutz Park to Vulcan Heritage, Foremost Trestle Trail and Lawrence University connection, Riverview Gardens connecting Veterans Park to Olde Oneida Street and Newberry Trail, and Plamann Park to Apple Hill Trail. And Whereas, bicycle advocates have fought hard for the right to the road and continue to shape our traffic laws to better accommodate people on bikes and all multimodal transportation choices, And

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that Appleton continues to grow our biking and walking community and plans to employ a shared employee in 2017 between Departments of Public Works and Park and Recreation to develop new programs, seek and apply for grants, enhance accommodations, and continue to make the City of Appleton a more bicycle and pedestrian friendly community.
