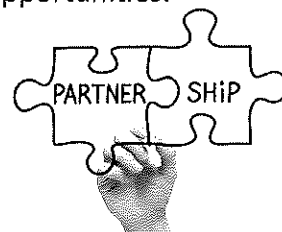

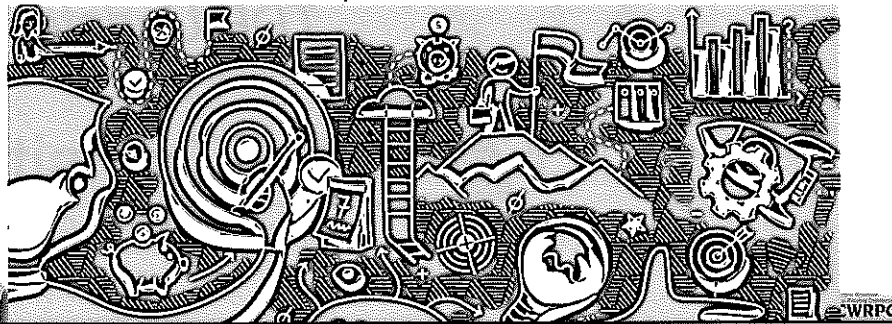
## Introduction

- Valley Transit (VT) and the East Central WI Regional Planning Commission (ECWRPC) received a planning grant through the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to update VT's Transit Development Plan (TDP).
- Planning activities have already begun, but the kick off meeting will be taking place in the beginning of 2018.
- Input into the planning process will be provided primarily through a series of meetings with members of a steering committee and additional public input opportunities.



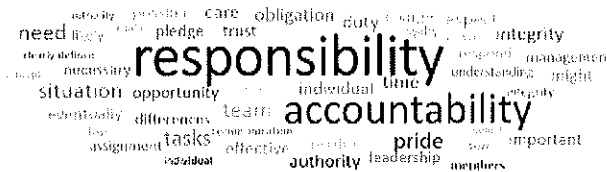
## What is a TDP?

- The purpose of the TDP is to guide the development of the bus system over the next five to ten years to ensure efficient and effective services.
- A TDP takes an in depth look at transit system operations including such service elements as: routes, times, policies, demographics, input from public comment/surveys, input from the steering committee as well as additional recommendations from public outreach efforts.



## Who is part of the process?

- A Transit Development Plan (TDP) is only as good as its steering committee! A steering committee not only guides the document from beginning to end, but also ensures that its recommendations become a reality. In addition to the steering committee the Fox Cities Transit Commission, funding partners and the public will be part of the process.

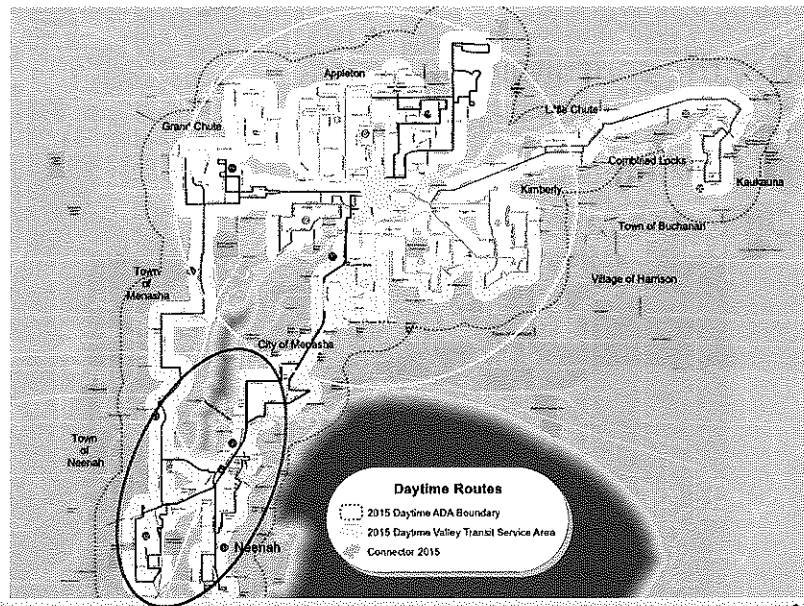
