INTRO:

Proposed 2026 paving:

Marston Alley (s/o Lawrence) (Spruce St to Summit St)

The alley listed above is proposed to undergo total reconstruction. The project to reconstruct the above listed alley will include the removal and replacement of all existing asphalt/concrete pavement, stone base, and driveways within the project limits.

MARSTON ALLEY – Spruce St to Summit St (380 LF) (2026 Concrete Pavt Reconstruct)

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

- Aldermanic District 10
- No parking along both sides of Marston Alley within project limits
- Pavement rating = 45
- Existing right of way width: 20'
- Existing pavement width: 19' (edge of pvmnt to edge of pvmnt)
- Existing Pavement
 - Asphalt/Asphalt year unknown
 - Asphalt placed in 1959
- Existing Storm Sewer
 - 12" CON constructed 1978

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- New concrete pavement – 19' (edge of pvmnt to edge of pvmnt)

COST ESTIMATES AND ASSESSMENTS

- Estimated Construction Cost = \$85,000

Dear Property Owner/Resident:

The City of Appleton is proposing to reconstruct the pavement on Marston Alley (south of Lawrence St), from Spruce Street to Summit Street, in 2026.

The Municipal Services Committee of the Common Council will conduct a formal design hearing regarding the proposed reconstruction of Marston Alley. At this meeting, the Committee will consider feedback from the public regarding the proposed design after the Engineering Division has presented its proposal to the Committee. The design hearing for Marston Alley is scheduled for Monday October 20th at 4:30 p.m. in Committee Room "A", Sixth Floor at the City Center Building.

The Committee will then meet again on Monday November 10th, at 4:30 p.m. to vote on the proposed alley design that would then go to the full Common Council on November 19th, 2025.

The proposed design option for Marston Alley is detailed as follows:

- New concrete pavement would be constructed at 19' wide from edge of concrete to edge of concrete. The proposed 19' wide alley is the same width as the existing alley.
