Out is In BINGO is just the way to do this! All you have to do is use the Out is In BINGO card and attain BINGO. There are 5 "free" spaces – the "FREE SPACE, B, I, N, G and O. The various ways you may achieve BINGO are, 4 corners – covering the top right and left corners as well as bottom right and left corners, cover 5 squares in a row vertically, or cover any 5 squares in a row (horizontal or diagonal). Although you cannot use BINGO as 5 squares horizontally for BINGO!
