**COMPLAINT**

On Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 5:00 p.m., the Safety and Licensing Committee of the Common Council for the City of Appleton, Wisconsin, will meet in committee room "A" of City Hall, 100 North Appleton Street, Appleton, Wisconsin, at which time the Appleton Police Department will ask the committee to recommend to the Common Council that it not renew the operator's license issued to **David A. Glaser**.

**REASONS FOR INTENDED ACTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.12(3) OF  
THE WISCONSIN STATUTES.**

The Appleton Police Department intends to ask for such a recommendation for the following reasons:

On July 15<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Fox Valley Metro Police Department arrested **David A. Glaser** for Operating While Intoxicated (4<sup>th</sup> Offense). Mr. Glaser was subsequently convicted of this offense on or about June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

In addition to this most recent conviction, Mr. Glaser was convicted of the following:



**RECOMMENDATION**

This most recent incident along with Mr. Glaser's previous arrests clearly show that the defendant, **David A. Glaser**, has engaged in illegal conduct substantially related to the licensed activity and that he does not possess the qualifications required under Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes to hold said license. In light of the seriousness and frequency of these violations, the Appleton Police Department is asking this committee not to renew **David A. Glaser's** operator's license.
