## AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 2-29 OF CHAPTER 2 ARTICLE II OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF APPLETON, RELATING TO ADMINISTRATION - COMMON COUNCIL.

The Common Council of the City of Appleton does ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 2-29 of Chapter 2, Article II, of the Municipal Code of the City of Appleton, relating to Administration, Common Council, is hereby created to read as follows:

## Sec. 2-29. Alderperson absence; participation by phone.

An alderperson unable to appear in person at any meeting may request in writing or by email at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the meeting the written or emailed permission from the President of the Common Council to participate in the meeting by telephone. The Council President may grant the request only upon finding good cause. An alderperson's appearance by telephone must be noted in the meeting agenda. Telephone participation must occur by speaker phone, with a speaker phone placed in the meeting room so that the physically absent member can hear and can be heard by all those who are present. An alderperson appearing by telephone shall be entitled to participate and vote to the fullest extent possible, but shall not vote on any matter that may require observation of any part of the proceeding, including the demeanor of a witness or viewing exhibits not previously provided. An alderperson participating by telephone shall not count towards a quorum.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
