- c. Change Library Park Lot meter hours from 9:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m. to 9 a.m. -6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, with Sundays remaining free.

New sidewalk would be constructed to the Right-of-Way line along the east side of Douglas from Pine Street to Rogers Avenue. Current on-street parking would remain unchanged.

New 4' sidewalk-would be constructed along the curb of the west leg of Winona Court. On street parking during non-winter months would remain unchanged. During winter months, on street parking would be prohibited along both-sides of Winona Court.
