

COMPLAINT

On Wednesday August 26, 2015 at 6:00 p.m., the Safety and Licensing Committee of the Common Council for the City of Appleton, Wisconsin, will meet in in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 100 North Appleton Street, Appleton, Wisconsin, at which time the Appleton Police Department will ask the committee to recommend to the Common Council that it not renew the operator's license issued to Jacob P. Henning.

**REASONS FOR INTENDED ACTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.12(3) OF THE
WISCONSIN STATUTES.**

The Appleton Police Department intends to ask for such a recommendation for the following reasons:

On May 18, 2014, the Appleton Police Department arrested Jacob P. Henning for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) as a third offense, Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration (PAC), Possession of Marijuana (THC), and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Mr. Henning was subsequently convicted of both Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) as a third offense and Possession of Marijuana (THC) on or about October 7, 2014.

In addition to the most recent convictions, Mr. Henning has been previously convicted of the following:

RECOMMENDATION

The most recent incident along with Mr. Henning's previous criminal history clearly show that the defendant, Jacob P. Henning, has engaged in illegal conduct substantially related to the licensed activity and that he does not possess the qualifications required under Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes to hold said license. In light of the seriousness and frequency of these violations, the Appleton Police Department is asking this committee not to renew Jacob P. Henning operator's license.
