WHEREAS, in Wisconsin, suicide is the 9th leading cause of death, with over 900 residents lost to suicide in 2024, impacting people of all ages, races, and socioeconomic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Appleton recognizes that suicide is preventable, and every life is valuable, which calls for community-wide collaboration, compassionate support, and accessible mental health resources to help those in need; and

WHEREAS, organizations like Prevent Suicide Fox Cities are leading local efforts to prevent suicide by offering resources, education, and support to individuals and families affected by suicide, promoting a message of hope and help throughout our community; and

WHEREAS, this month serves as a time to remind our community that mental health care and suicide prevention resources are available, and there is no shame in seeking help, as well as to honor the memory of those who have lost their lives to suicide and offer support to those grieving their loss.
