

1. The name of a significant local, state, or national historical figure (**deceased**), **historical group or people**, or a significant local, state, or national historical event.
2. The name of an adjacent street.
3. The name of a unique geologic or geographic feature or other natural attribute that characterizes the park (e.g., a dominant tree species).
4. The name of a major donor instrumental in the acquisition or development of the park.
5. The commonly accepted name of the surrounding neighborhood which comprises a significant portion of the service area of the park.
6. The name of an individual who has performed an outstanding service for the community (preferably in the area of parks and recreation).
7. **A combined name that includes a qualifying element from the above criteria together with a universally positive or thematic concept (e.g., values, virtues, or inspirational ideas).**

Example: Ellen Kort Peace Park.
