Historic Preservation Commission – New Appointments

Joe Gaerthofner - Historian

Term Ends May 2027

Joe Gaerthofner has been a citizen of Appleton for over 50 years with a deep passion for preserving and sharing the city's history. Since 2010, he has created and led history walking tours at Riverside Cemetery, focusing on themes such as "Appleton & WWI" and "Appleton & The Civil War." These tours have become a significant part of the Appleton Historical Society's summer programming, most recently highlighted by a Civil War-themed tour over Memorial Day weekend. Joe served on the History Museum's Board of Directors and has contributed several articles to its newsletter. Over the years, he has been invited to give numerous presentations, including one at the Appleton Historical Society's April meeting this year, where his talk on a forgotten event from 1921 was recorded and shared online. Recently, he has also been invited to present at the Appleton Public Library, demonstrating his continued commitment to the community's historical education. Joe has also appeared on WHBY's Focus Fox Valley with Haley Tenpas, discussing Appleton's rich history. Joe lives with his wife, Jen, and their son, Elijah, in the Peabody Park area and is an Account Manager with Nordon Business Environments, his family-owned business headquartered in Appleton, WI.
