Subject: Request to Approve Parking changes at 100 Block of S. Summit Street
(follow-up to a 6-month evaluation)

In response to a citizen's request, the City's Traffic Section recently assessed the on-street parking on Summit St between College Av and Lawrence St. The initial review found tight parking along the entire two block section occasionally around noon and early evening due to the traffic generated by Mill City Public House at 1103 W College Av.

The evaluation period was initiated in November of 2025. It included installation of a parking restriction on the west side of Summit St near Kimball Alley and a parking restriction on the east side of Summit St south of Kimball Alley to College Av. See Figure 1 below.

This arrangement has had the desired effect, and the Traffic Section has not received any feedback from the community. Based on this, it is recommended the changes be made permanent. To accomplish this, the following ordinance changes are necessary:

1. **Create:** "Parking be prohibited on the west side of Summit Street from a point 8 feet north of Kimball Alley to a point 6 feet south of Kimball Alley."
2. **Create:** "Parking be prohibited on the east side of Summit Street from College Avenue to a point 7 feet south of Kimball Alley."
