- 2. That the City of Appleton hereby determines that it is necessary and of public purpose to install soil tie backs necessary for the public parking ramp on Kimball Street in or near the City of Appleton, Wisconsin.
- 3. That said soil tie backs will be installed within the area marked on the scale drawing, which is attached to this Relocation Order as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein;

SECTION THRU RAMP AND MOSAIC AT KIMBALL

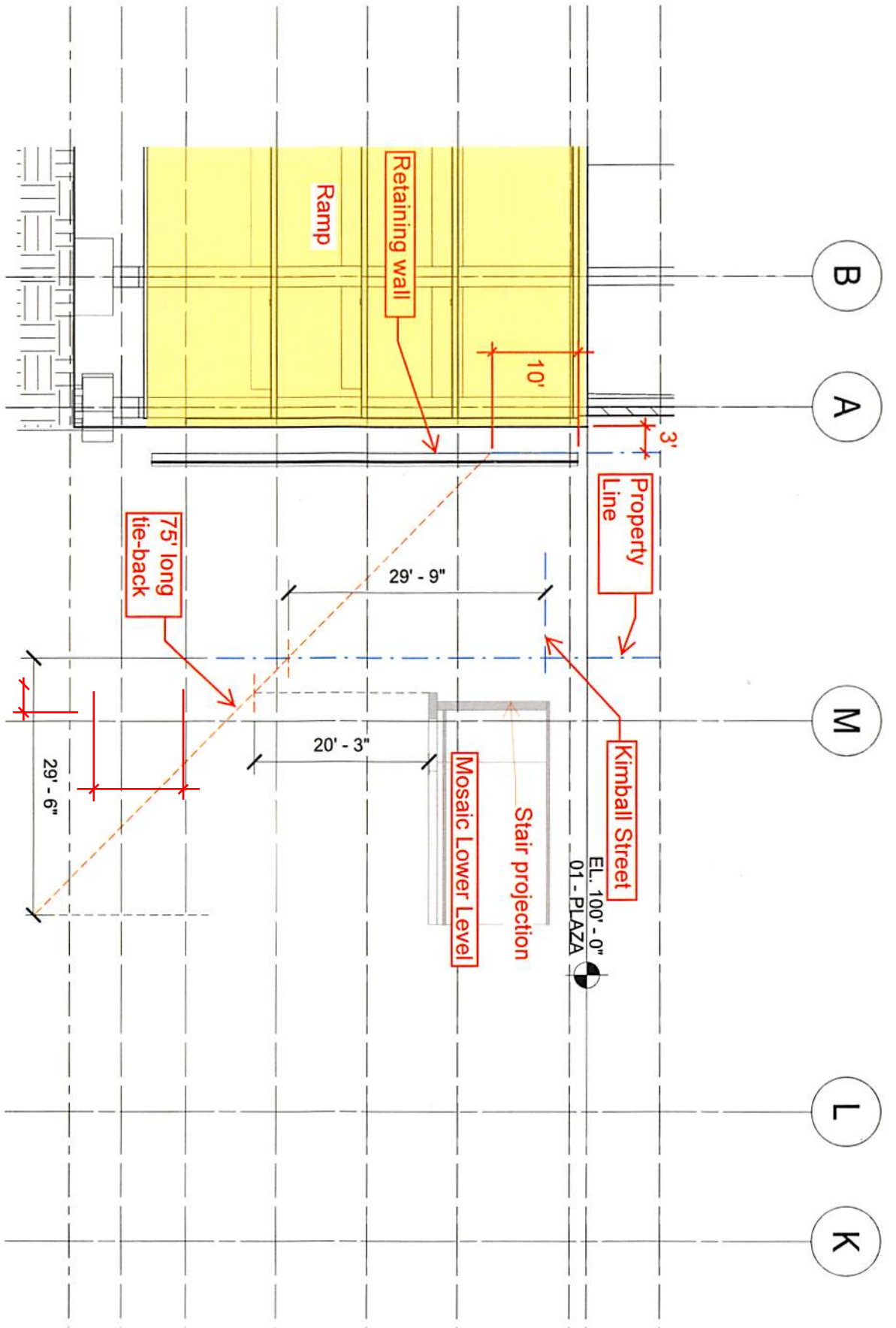
