

COMPLAINT

On Wednesday August 26, 2015 at 6:00 p.m., the Safety and Licensing Committee of the Common Council for the City of Appleton, Wisconsin, will meet in in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 100 North Appleton Street, Appleton, Wisconsin, at which time the Appleton Police Department will ask the committee to recommend to the Common Council that it not renew the operator's license issued to Debbie Erickson.

**REASONS FOR INTENDED ACTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.12(3) OF THE
WISCONSIN STATUTES.**

The Appleton Police Department intends to ask for such a recommendation for the following reasons:

On August 9 2014, the Appleton Police Department arrested Debbie Erickson for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) as a second offense and Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration (PAC). Ms. Erickson was subsequently convicted of Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) as a second offense on or about November 3, 2014.

In addition to the most recent conviction, Ms. Erickson has been convicted of the following:

OWI (1st) with a minor Passenger

DATE OF CONVICTION
June 30, 2010

RECOMMENDATION

The most recent incident along with Ms. Erickson's previous criminal history clearly show that the defendant, Debbie Erickson, has engaged in illegal conduct substantially related to the licensed activity and that he does not possess the qualifications required under Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes to hold said license. In light of the seriousness of these violations, the Appleton Police Department is asking this committee not to renew Debbie Erickson operator's license.
