INTRO:

On October 18, 2017 we conducted Public Information Sessions for:

Evergreen Drive Alvin Street (Alvin St to Haymeadow Ave) (Evergreen Dr to Cul de Sac)

All streets listed above are proposed to undergo a total reconstruction and transition from a rural roadway (ditches/no curb & gutter/no sidewalk) to an urban street (curb & gutter/sidewalk). The project to reconstruct the above listed streets will include the removal of all existing asphalt/concrete pavement, stone base, and driveway apron within the project limits. New concrete pavement with curb & gutter and sidewalks are proposed for both Evergreen Drive and Alvin Street.

The pavement rating shown is based on the City's pavement rating system with values from 1 to 100 with 100 being the worst.

EVERGREEN DRIVE - Alvin St to Haymeadow Ave (2019 Concrete Pavt Reconstruct)

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

- Pavement rating = 52
- Existing right of way width = 66', 73'
- Existing pavement width (edge of pvmnt to edge of pvmnt/rural with ditches) = 24'
- Existing Pavement
 - o Asphalt 2003
- Existing Water Main
 - o 12" PVC constructed 1994
- Existing Sanitary Sewer
 - o 12" PVC constructed 2003

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Underground utilities to be improved in 2018.
- New concrete pavement 38' (back of curb to back of curb)
- 1 travel lane in each direction
- New bike lanes along both sides of Evergreen Drive.
- New 10' trail along north side of Evergreen Dr, within project limits
- New 5' sidewalk along south side of Evergreen Dr, within project limits
- New concrete driveway aprons within project limits

COST ESTIMATES AND ASSESSMENTS

• Estimated Construction Cost = \$1,000,000

PUBLIC MEETING FEEDBACK

- 31 Properties along project limits, 28 property owner attended the public info meeting
- 10 questionnaire were returned
 - o Feedback:
 - Concerns regarding access during construction.
 - Concerns over the need for a 10' trail along north side
 - Concerns over increased speeding after project
 - Concerns over the effect on landscaping and trees by adding 10' trail
 - Some town residents along south side not in favor of adding sidewalk
 - Why bike lanes and 10' trail? Redundant?
 - Concerns regarding drainage after ditches are gone
 - Concerns that 10' trail doesn't "go anywhere"

ALVIN STREET - Evergreen Dr to Cul de Sac (2019 Concrete Pavt Reconstruct)

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

- Pavement rating = n/a (Town of Grand Chute street)
- Existing right of way width = 66'
- Existing pavement width (edge of pymnt to edge of pymnt/rural with ditches) = 22'
- Existing Pavement
 - o n/a (records of pavement age unavailable)
- Existing Water Main
 - o 12" PVC constructed 2009
- Existing Sanitary Sewer
 - o 10" PVC constructed 2009

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Underground utilities to be improved in 2018.
- New concrete curb & gutter and asphalt pavement 33' (back of curb to back of curb)
- New 5' sidewalk along both sides of Alvin Dr, within project limits
- New concrete driveway aprons within project limits

COST ESTIMATES AND ASSESSMENTS

• Estimated Construction Cost = \$250,000

PUBLIC MEETING FEEDBACK

- 7 Properties along project limits, 2 property owners signed in at public info meeting
- 1 questionnaire was returned
 - Feedback: concerns regarding a potential future re-development along Alvin Street and a suggestion to hold off on any reconstruction of Alvin Street until more is known about that future development.
