

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CREATING TAX INCREMENTAL DISTRICT
AND PROPOSED PROJECT PLAN
TAX INCREMENTAL DISTRICT NO. 12

Please take notice the City of Appleton Plan Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at 4:00 P.M. in Common Council Chambers, 6th Floor, City Hall, 100 North Appleton Street to consider a proposal to create a tax incremental district, the boundaries of which would be within the area outlined on the map shown and are generally described as the West College Avenue corridor from Badger Avenue/Story Street intersection to Walnut Street.

Such hearing shall also be for the purpose of considering the proposed project plan and boundary for such tax incremental district, which is designated as a rehabilitation district for the purpose of assisting with the rehabilitation, conservation and redevelopment of vacant, blighted, and underutilized properties as needed to support the urban renewal of this corridor. Proposed projects include, but are not limited to: municipal infrastructure improvements, environmental audits and remediation, promotion and development, professional services, financing costs and other related administrative costs, and approximately \$1,679,176 in development incentives in the form of cash grants or loans to property owners, lessees, or developers for carrying out the purpose of eliminating blight and stimulating the rehabilitation of this business corridor.

At said hearing, all interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to be heard to express their views on the proposed creation of the district and the proposed project plan.
