

DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

City of Appleton | North Appleton Properties, LLC

Comet Ridge Development

THIS AGREEMENT, made by and between the City of Appleton, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, a body politic and municipal corporation by its Common Council (“**City**”) and, North Appleton Properties, LLC (“**Developer**”), which is the part owner and developer of certain property lying within the city of Appleton, the remaining ownership of which is held by the Jane E. Dorn Revocable Trust, collectively referred to herein as the “**Property Owners.**”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Developer has proposed to develop the Comet Ridge Development (“**Comet Ridge**”), a residential subdivision on property, owned within the corporate limits of the City described in **Exhibit 1** attached hereto; said; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 of the Appleton Municipal Code provides for the installation of required improvements in new subdivisions;

WHEREAS, a preliminary plat of Comet Ridge, shown in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto, has been conditionally approved by the Common Council on October 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a phasing plan has been developed, shown in **Exhibit 3** attached hereto, illustrating how the final platting of the property is contemplated to occur in phases over time; and

WHEREAS, a final plat of Comet Ridge, phase one, shown in **Exhibit 4** attached hereto, has been submitted to the City for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, a series of meetings and negotiations have taken place between the City and the Developer to determine various development and financial responsibilities between the City and the Developer for on-site and off-site public improvements and fees in connection with the proposed subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Developer, for their mutual benefit, desire to set forth their respective duties and responsibilities with respect to the development of the Land, and have mutually agreed as to development and financial responsibilities for public improvements and fees in connection with the proposed subdivision.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, the parties agree as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES**

- 1.01 The City represents and warrants to Developer that the City has the power, authority and legal right to enter into all of the transactions and to perform all of the covenants and obligations required to be entered into or performed by the City under this Agreement.
- 1.01.01 The City represents and warrants to Developer that it is empowered and authorized to execute and deliver this Agreement and other agreements and documents, if any, required hereunder to be executed and delivered by the City. This Agreement has been, and each such document at the time it is executed and delivered, will be duly executed and delivered on behalf of the City.
- 1.01.02 When executed and delivered to Developer, all such agreements shall constitute a legal, valid and binding obligation of the City, enforceable in accordance with its terms.
- 1.01.03 The City further represents that this Agreement and the terms and conditions contained herein are consistent with adopted ordinances and resolutions on the subject matter at the time of agreement. The city agrees that with respect to the provision of parks, trails, and complete streets, platting and development of future phases shall comply with the adopted City Plans and policies in existence at the date this agreement was executed. Relevant city plans include the Complete Streets Guide and policy, the Official Map; the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan, the Trails Master Plan, and the City Comprehensive Plan – *Plan Appleton*.
- 1.02 The Developer represents and warrants to the City that Developer is a Limited Liability Corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and that all proceedings of Developer necessary to authorize the negotiation and execution of this Agreement and the consummation of the transaction contemplated by this Agreement have been taken in accordance with applicable law.
- 1.02.01 The Developer represents and warrants to the City that the execution and delivery of this Agreement, the consummation of the transactions contemplated in this Agreement and the execution and delivery of the documents required to be executed, delivered or acknowledged by Developer at the closing will not violate any provision of Developer's partnership

agreement or any applicable statute, rule, regulation, judgment, order or decree of the State of Wisconsin or a court having jurisdiction over Developer or its properties.

ARTICLE II. DEVELOPER RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.01 The Developer shall be responsible for the installation of the following:
- 2.01.01 Sanitary sewer mains, manholes and laterals;
 - 2.01.02 Water mains, valves, hydrants, hydrant leads, fittings and services;
 - 2.01.03 Storm sewer mains, manholes, catch basins, inlet leads, overland flow paths, yard drains and associated piping and laterals;
 - 2.01.04 Storm water facilities necessary to meet storm water management requirements for the development;
 - 2.01.05 Street excavation and graveling, terrace seeding, lot filling and grading and seeding; and
 - 2.01.06 All other infrastructure required for development not specifically set forth in this agreement.
- 2.02 The Developer shall provide an estimate for items in Sections 2.01.01-2.01.06, for each phase of the project, subject to the City's review and approval, prior to the installation of the items for the Proposed Subdivision. The Developer shall provide the City an initial financial guarantee in the amount of 120% of the total identified within the Developer-financed construction column in Exhibit 6. Said guarantee shall be in the form of a performance bond, irrevocable letter of credit, cash held in escrow, or similar guarantee determined to be equivalent by the City. The guarantee will be released in whole or in part after the City, in its sole discretion, determines requirements of the development have been met. Within 60 days of the Developer's request for a partial release of the Letter of Credit, the City shall either advise of corrections to be made or shall reduce the Letter of Credit by the documented and verified expenditure of completed improvements.
- 2.03 The Developer shall provide a fully executed and signed *Waivers of Special Assessment Notices and Hearing (Exhibit 5)* for the development, acknowledging and consenting to pay the Special Assessment levied by the City for the items in Sections 2.03.01 – 2.03.08, as set forth herein, that may be furnished and/or installed by the City.

An estimate of costs and associated special assessments to be paid by the Developer for items 2.03.01-2.03.08 for the development are attached hereto as **Exhibit 6**. The actual final costs for said items will be used as the basis for the special assessments billed to the Development and following the City's Special Assessment Policy at the time of billing.

Concrete paving and sidewalks will be assessed to the abutting property owners in accordance with the City's Special Assessment Policy. Concrete paving and sidewalks adjacent to any regional stormwater pond will be equally and fairly assessed on a per-lot basis to each Development Property that is served by any regional stormwater facility.

The Developer will only be assessed for the cost of those lots owned by the Developer.

Concrete streets shall be installed, no sooner than, seventy-five (75%) of the lots in the Proposed Development have been issued building permits or after a five (5) year period. Road cuts and proof rolls shall not occur during frozen/cold weather conditions. Building permits can be issued prior to asphalt road surface installation provided all other required approvals are received in order to proceed, and once the City has opened the streets to the public.

The Developer acknowledges that the following may be furnished and/or installed by the City, subject to Developer's signing of **Exhibit 5**:

- 2.03.01 City Administrative Fees
 - 2.03.02 Temporary Asphalt Roadway and Trails
 - 2.03.03 Sanitary Sewer Area Assessment
 - 2.03.04 Sewer Televising
 - 2.03.05 Street Names/Traffic Control Signs
 - 2.03.06 Concrete Pavement abutting lots owned by the Developer at the time of concrete paving
 - 2.03.07 Concrete sidewalks and sidepaths installed on lots owned by the Developer at the time of concrete paving
- 2.04 The Developer's responsibilities related to the North Sanitary Sewer Project shall include:
- 2.04.01 Executing of and costs related to environmental investigations and permitting (wetland and waterways), geotechnical testing for the entirety of the project.

The Developer will be promptly reimbursed by the City for necessary and reasonable Martenson & Eisele fees for aforementioned work. The Developer is responsible for maintaining accurate and complete records of all costs associated with the work including invoices, receipts, contracts, and documentation related to the costs.

- 2.04.02 Creation and acquisition of sanitary sewer easement (from CTH JJ south to northern plat line) Sanitary sewer connection from limits of project west of Kurt Avenue (**Exhibit 7**) to subdivision sanitary sewer at Marv Avenue.
- 2.05 The Developer shall be responsible for the design, permitting, and costs related to:
 - 2.05.01 A trail connection to Thornbrook Estates within Outlot 2 of Comet Ridge Plat, in accordance with City of Appleton Department of Parks and Recreation standards and specifications, at the time of street excavation and gravelling.
 - 2.05.02 Sidepaths, which shall be constructed initially in 8-inch gravel concurrently with street excavation and gravelling, , as illustrated in **Exhibit 8** – Comet Ridge Plat – New Street Design Approvals. The Developer acknowledges and accepts that the City shall not maintain nor plow the sidepath if any portion of the sidepath remains unpaved. Further, the Developer acknowledges and accepts that in the interim condition, there may be undesirable apron grades prior to the concrete paving of the street.
 - 2.05.03 Each phase of construction, is subject to additional detailed stormwater and infrastructure review (including but not limited to water, sanitary, surface drainage, storm sewer, and storm water treatment facilities) due to the level of assumptions made and/or feasibility-level analysis provided. Assumptions incorporated within any models and analyses that result in insufficient level of treatment and capacity for conveyance may result in reconfiguration/reconstruction of any infrastructure installed prior to completion of a comprehensive and detailed analysis.
- 2.06 The Developer shall provide the City with copies of all final costs, invoices, labor costs, the contract documents and specifications, design documentation, all contract administration supporting documentation, an itemized list of all expenses for the installation of sanitary sewer, storm sewer, water main, street excavation and graveling, sidepath and trail construction, and all appurtenances. Said information provided by Developer shall meet City’s Infrastructure Adjustment Form requirements. The Developer’s design engineer shall perform the construction staking and the City shall inspect the same.

- 2.07 The Developer’s contractor shall perform the testing of the water main, sanitary sewer and storm sewer under the supervision of the City of Appleton inspectors.
- 2.08 The Developer shall provide lien waivers to the City from the prime contractor, subcontractors, suppliers and consultants.
- 2.09 The Developer agrees to convey by deed or dedication to the City all the streets, roads, courts, avenues, drives, and public ways in the Plat. Developer further agrees to convey any public access ways by dedication or easement to the City. All public improvements contemplated in the final plat shall be constructed within areas to be dedicated to the City either by deed, dedication or easement as contemplated in the final plat and this Agreement.
- 2.10 The Developer plans to construct a pond on Outlot 3 of the Comet Ridge preliminary plat (“O.L. 3 pond”) to meet storm water management requirements. The City is agreeable to taking ownership of O.L. 3 pond contingent upon certain requirements:
- 2.10.01 The O.L. 3 pond transfer of ownership from developer to city is contingent upon an agreement being executed between developer and Stone Ridge West Estates that provides for public storm water conveyance to the pond and authorization of use of pond capacity that meets all applicable ordinance requirements.
- 2.10.02 The O.L. 3 pond will be accepted for City ownership at no cost no sooner than upon completion of construction of seventy-five percent (75%) of the lots in the Proposed Development that are tributary to the pond provided that all active farming operations within the drainage area tributary to the regional pond have permanently ceased, and when perennial surface vegetation (low mow fescue) is fully established in accordance with City specifications.
- 2.10.03 The pond will be constructed initially by Developer with an annual cover crop and perennial low mow fescue with a final landscape plan for the pond provided by the City.
- 2.10.04 Prior to the transfer of O.L. 3 pond, the Developer shall inspect and maintain the pond and all temporary drainage swales tributary to the pond in accordance with City standards per an Operation and Maintenance agreement that is subject to City approval, shall provide documentation demonstrating compliance with the approved Stormwater Management Plan, including as-built pond survey, bathymetric survey demonstrating a minimum of five (5) feet of sediment storage capacity between the pond normal water level and the pond bottom at all locations, and a professional engineer certification confirming the pond has been constructed in accordance with City approved

plans and specifications.

The Developer shall provide the City with copies of the recorded drainage easements as signed and recorded by the Developer with ten (10) days of execution of this Agreement.

- 2.11 Upon completion of construction, and prior to acceptance of streets, the Developer shall provide a certification from a professional land surveyor licensed in the State of Wisconsin that all monumentation within the development is properly installed within three inches (3") of finished grade.
- 2.12 The Developer shall establish a level loop on the hydrants in the plat and a copy of those benchmarks shall be provided to the City.
- 2.13 The Developer shall repair or replace existing City infrastructure and/or monumentation, as directed by the City and to the City's satisfaction, at his own cost, any damage caused by the installation of any improvements within the Proposed Development.
- 2.14 The estimate of costs paid by the Developer for items 2.03.01-2.03.08 for Comet Ridge (Phase 1) is attached hereto as **Exhibit 6** and shows the items and amounts projected to be paid by the Developer. The actual final costs for these items will be used as the basis for the special assessments billed to the developer, for all phases of the development. Developer shall provide cost estimates to the City for all future phases of development.
- 2.15 The Developer shall pay the cost of all items listed in 2.03.01-2.03.08, subject to the following related to sidewalks and sidepaths: the owner of each lot shall be responsible for the lot's sidewalk or sidepath construction and related expense. Sidewalks or sidepaths shall be installed by the respective property owner within 6 months of the issuance of a building permit. Any frontage where the sidewalk or sidepath has not been installed by the time the City installs the permanent concrete pavements (typically 5 to 10 years from the recording of the plat) will be installed by the City and the cost assessed against the respective lot per the City's Special Assessment Policy in place at the time of concrete paving.
- 2.16 The Schedule for the Proposed Development shall be as follows:
 - 2.16.01 Infrastructure installation may commence after approvals of all phases of platting as follows: City approval of Final Plat, Drainage Plan, Established Grades, Storm Water Management Plan, Plans and Specifications;
 - 2.16.02 Building permits may be issued upon City approval and acceptance of all infrastructure. Streets must be officially opened to the public by the City Engineer prior to the issuance of building permits.

- 2.17 Developer shall complete all phases, as outlined in **Exhibit 3**, of the Proposed Development within 5 years of the date of the signing of this agreement. Any phases of development not completed within 5 years will require a new or amended development agreement. Regardless of timing, any subsequent phases of the development must be adopted and approved in a new or amended development agreement.
- 2.18 The Developer shall pay the entire cost associated with installation of underground gas, electric, telephone, USPS mail delivery facilities, and cable TV utilities and streetlights. Streetlights shall be standard wooden poles. The street lighting plan shall be designed by We Energies and approved by the City. The City shall pay We Energies the monthly electrical charge for street lighting. If the Developer desires decorative streetlights, then the Developer will be responsible for all costs associated with the decorative streetlights. The Developer will be responsible for requesting said decorative lights from We Energies. The Developer must also sign a Waiver of Special Assessments document for the annual assessments associated with decorative lighting.
- 2.19 Developer recognizes the City will not own nor maintain USPS mailboxes and/or cluster mailbox units. Developer shall make provisions for the permitting, installation, and maintenance of said mailboxes by future property owners and/or homeowners' association(s).

**ARTICLE III.
DEVELOPER AND CITY SHARED RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 3.01 Developer and City agree that there will be no parkland dedication in this development. The City has exercised its option for Fee in Lieu of Parkland Dedication, to be payable at the time of building permit in accordance with Section 17-29 Appleton Municipal Code.
- 3.02 Developer and City agree that, as it relates to the Sanitary Sewer Southern Connection:
- 3.02.01 City shall decommission the sewer lift station on O.L. 1 of Marshall Heights Subdivision, as illustrated in **Exhibit 7**.
- 3.02.02 The Developer shall include the design, permitting and installation of sanitary sewer main from south plat line to existing gravity sanitary sewer main within Marshall Heights Subdivision.

**ARTICLE IV.
CITY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 4.01 The City agrees that it shall be responsible for the following:

- 4.01.1 Budget, Design, County Highway right-of-way permitting specific to the Sanitary Sewer Project; and
 - 4.01.2 Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources permitting for sewer extension and Notice of Intent specific to the Sanitary Sewer Project; and
 - 4.01.3 The creation of sanitary sewer easement (from CTH JJ north to Spartan Drive, as illustrated in **Exhibit 7** and any associated City Permits.
 - 4.01.4 Prepare a final landscape plan for the O.L. 3 pond. Upon ownership transfer, the City will install native seed and plantings on the pond sideslopes and emergent zones, respectively, and assess all associated costs on a per lot basis for all lots tributary to the regional pond
- 4.02 The City further agrees that it shall be responsible for constructing the North Sanitary Sewer project between Spartan Drive and a point located at the north Plat Line of Comet Ridge, as illustrated in **Exhibit 7**.
- 4.03 The City agrees to accept the dedication of all the Public Improvements in the plat, whether by deed, dedication or easement subject to the City's acceptance of the Public Improvements in accordance with and subject to the terms of the City's Subdivision Ordinance and this Agreement.

ARTICLE V. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

- 5.01 This Agreement, along with **Exhibits 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8**, sets forth the entire understanding of the parties relative to its subject matter and supersedes and merges any and all prior communications, negotiations and agreements, oral or written.
- 5.02 It is understood and agreed that the provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed severable and the invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more of the provisions contained herein shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions contained herein.
- 5.03 This Agreement may not be modified or amended, except in writing, with the written consent of both the City and the Developer.
- 5.04 **Notices.** All notices, states, and other communications given hereunder shall be made in writing by personal delivery or by mailing the same by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by next day express delivery, addressed to the other as aforesaid, and the date of such

personal delivery the next day if any express delivery, or the date five (5) days after such mailing shall be deemed the date on which such notice is effective. Except as otherwise specified herein, all notices sent to the City hereunder shall be directed to the attention of the Mayor.

Since the City's adoption of the Complete Streets Design Guide and Complete Streets Policy in 2024, the Department of Public Works (DPW) has presented new street design criteria to the Municipal Services Committee and Common Council for approval prior to Final Plat.

Action Item:

Approve the roadway design parameters for proposed streets in the Comet Ridge plat as follows:

- Haymeadow Avenue (north plat limits to Apple Creek Road and south plat limits to approximately 160 feet north of Garks Drive):
 - Collector street designation.
 - 60' right-of-way.
 - 5' concrete sidewalk on both sides along the right-of-way line.
 - 8.5' vegetated terraces on both sides, adjacent to sidewalks.
 - Street having a future concrete pavement section with curb & gutter; the pavement section is 33' wide (from back of curb to back of curb).
 - On-street parking on both sides.
 - Future supplemental traffic calming spot features may be determined administratively with final design.

- Haymeadow Avenue (Apple Creek Road to approximately 160 feet north of Garks Drive):
 - Collector street designation.
 - 60' right-of-way.
 - 5' concrete sidewalk on west side along the right-of-way line.
 - 10' concrete side path on east side along the right-of-way line.
 - 6' vegetated terraces on both sides, adjacent to sidewalks.
 - Street having a future concrete pavement section with curb & gutter; the pavement section is 33' wide (from back of curb to back of curb).
 - On-street parking on both sides.
 - Future supplemental traffic calming spot features may be determined administratively with final design.

- Apple Creek Road (east plat limits to STH47/Richmond Street):
 - Collector street designation.
 - 60' right-of-way.
 - 5' concrete sidewalk on north side along the right-of-way line.
 - 10' concrete side path on south side along the right-of-way line.
 - 7.5' vegetated terraces on both sides, adjacent to sidewalks.
 - Street having a future concrete pavement section with curb & gutter; the pavement section is 30' wide (from back of curb to back of curb).
 - On-street parking on one side only.
 - Future supplemental traffic calming spot features may be determined administratively with final design.

- Chester Lane (Haymeadow Av to Todd Dr), Jane Court (Haymeadow Av to cul de sac), Todd Drive (Apple Creek Rd to Kurt Av), Kurt Avenue (north plat limits to Clayhill Dr), Marv Avenue (north plat limits to Marshall Heights Av), Clayhill Drive (Marshall Heights Av to south plat limits), Marshal Heights Avenue (Clayhill Dr to south plat limits), Ductile Lane (Marshall Heights Av to cul de sac), Dorn Lane (Haymeadow Av to Garks Dr), Garks Drive (Haymeadow Av to south plat limits)
 - Local street designation
 - 60' right-of-way.
 - 5' concrete sidewalks on both sides along the right-of-way line.
 - 11.5' vegetated terraces on both sides, adjacent to sidewalks.
 - Street having a future concrete pavement section with curb & gutter; the pavement section is 27' wide (from back of curb to back of curb).
 - On-street parking on one side only.
 - Future supplemental traffic calming spot features may be determined administratively with final design.
