Re: Action: Award Renovation and Addition to the Pierce Park Pavilion Project to

Milbach Construction Services in the amount of \$328,135.00 with a contingency of

\$46,744.00 for a contract total not to exceed \$374,879.00.

The bids for the Renovation and Addition to the Pierce Park Pavilion Project were opened on Wednesday, May 21, 2014. The project includes the demolition of the existing exterior band shelter and construction of a new performance area and roof structure on the east side of the pavilion.

Seven bids were received for the project. Milbach Construction Services was determined to be the low bidder. The base bid for the demolition of the existing exterior structure and construction of a new performance area and roof structure is \$311,625.00. It is the recommendation of the Parks, Recreation and Facilities Management Department to accept an alternate bid of \$11,185.00 to upgrade the lighting for the open picnic area under the pavilion to LED fixtures to match the new renovations and also accept an alternate bid of \$5,325.00 to update all the pavilion soffit lights to LED fixtures to match the new lighting planned for the new renovations. In addition, we are recommending a 15% contingency on the base bid of \$311,625.00 for a contract total with alternates to be \$374,879.00. A larger contingency is being recommended as no original drawings or specifications were available for this project. We performed as much due diligence as feasibly could have been completed without having these documents available.

The Parks, Recreation and Facilities Management Department's Capital Projects Fund includes a budget of \$500,000 for this project. The balance of the project budget will be used in 2014 to issue a separate contract to complete the necessary paving around the new addition to the pavilion to accommodate pedestrian and vehicular access.

It is the recommendation of the Parks, Recreation and Facilities Management Department to award the contract to Milbach Construction Services for \$374,879.00. Construction will begin in late August/early September to allow the regularly scheduled activities in Pierce Park to take place this summer. Substantial completion of the project is planned for the end of 2014, weather permitting.
