Re: Request to Approve Time-Sensitive 2022 Council Chamber Change Order

As described in §P.2.e and §P.3.a in the City of Appleton's Procurement and Contract Management Policy last updated on October 7, 2015:

Approve Amendment and Change Order #1 to the 2022 Council Chamber Technology Upgrade project (CityLaw file 22-0647) to increase for "additional signal transmission hardware" in the amount of \$4,871. Overall contract increased from \$49,930 to \$54,801.

Proceeding with the Change Order process as described in §P.2.d would result in a hardware procurement delay of 1-6 weeks (1 week if I request an emergency HR/IT Committee session; 6 based on the current Committee and Council calendar). This will result in continued issues broadcasting and recording remote participants until the hardware can be procured and installed. The current issue also contributes to difficulties displaying presentations in the chamber. With consideration to the critical timing of this Change Order and the fact that the 9.7% cost increase falls within the original \$60,000 budgeted for the project, along with the potential for procurement delays, I believe enacting paragraph §P.2.e is a reasonable and appropriate response to the Change Order, and I am seeking your approval.

### **Technical Description for the Record**

Camera Corner/Connecting Point's technology design re-used signal transmission hardware that was shown to have been part of the existing system based on the original installer's records. However, the necessary signal transmission hardware is not on site, and the advanced, dynamic mixing of video signals to the three new displays cannot be achieved without it.

# Committees and Common Council Review


I present this memo to the Finance Committee as an action item and to the HR/IT Committee as an information item. It is presented to the Appleton Common Council for final approval based on the Finance Committee's recommendation.

# Background

Earlier in 2022, the Council approved a \$60,000 IT budget carryover from the 2021 budget for a Council chamber technology upgrade. The upgrade includes the installation of a fourth video camera, four new display screens, a hearing loop, reprogramming of all microphones, and three new Internet-connected digital clocks. The RFP (Request for Proposals) also allowed suppliers to bid several optional components, including design reviews and tuning of the audio and video systems as well as the cleaning and dressing of the microphone closet. The costs contained within this memo include the estimates for the optional components.

### **RFP Process**

The RFP contained a list of requirements, terms and conditions, and requests for information. A four-member panel received and evaluated four proposals based upon pre-established criteria covering Project Specifications and Requirements, Qualifications and Experience, Terms and Conditions, Appleton/Fox Valley Business Advantage, and Price Proposal. Proposals were scored individually and collectively, and ranked according to total score as follows (400 pts. possible):

including Change Orders, shall be reported as an informational item to the Committee of Jurisdiction prior to issuing final payment.

- c. All Change Orders not included in either of the paragraphs above must be recommended by the Committee of Jurisdiction and approved by the City Council prior to the contractor being authorized to begin work.
- d. If approval of the Change Order results in the contract amount exceeding the remaining contingency and/or the project budget, recommendation of the contract amendment must be obtained from the Finance Committee, Committee of Jurisdiction, and approved by the Common Council prior to beginning any work under the Change Order.
- e. If, in the determination of the Mayor, the work called for under a proposed Change Order is a Critical Timing situation, the Change Order may be authorized by the Mayor, in consultation with Department Head and Director of Finance. Any such approval shall be reported to the Common Council as an informational item at its next regularly scheduled meeting or within thirty (30) days, whichever is sooner.
