MUNICIPAL SERVICES COMMITTEE:

"WHEREAS Section 16-10 of the City of Appleton's Municipal Code pertains to snow and ice removal on sidewalks, requiring the clearing of walks within 36 hours of the cessation of a snowfall.

And WHEREAS violations of said section of the municipal code can result in the city clearing the snow at the owner's expense,

And WHEREAS it is reasonable and understandable for property owners to be away from home for more than 36 hours at a time in the days surrounding the Thanksgiving. Christmas and New Years holidays.

And WHEREAS holiday schedules may make it difficult for property owners to make alternate snow removal arrangements during that time,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Appleton shall amend its snow and ice removal policy to allow property owners 72 hours to clear their sidewalks if a snowfall occurs between Wednesday and Sunday of the week of Thanksgiving or between December 24 and January 1."

ATTORNEY'S OFFICE:

"Be it resolved:

- (1) That staff is directed to administratively correct all references in the Rules of Council and Department and Committee Functions to reflect that under the Granicus system "Reports" are now "Minutes" and that "FOR INFORMATION ONLY" is now entitled "Information Items."
- (2) That Rule 12 of Department and Committee Functions be amended to read as follows:

Reports – All items appearing on the Committee/Commission/Board Agendas shall be reported out to the Common Council. Issues with critical timing shall be so indicated on the Minutes. The vote shall be recorded indicating which members voted nay or abstained from the vote. All Minutes shall have, after the signature of the Chair and the attendance of members, a section called "Information Items". Items from Committee/Commission/Boards Agendas that were postponed, tabled, withdrawn or referred to another committee shall be included in this section with a date specific for the item to be acted on and shall not be debatable. Suspensions of the Rules (2/3 vote) is needed to move an information item to an action item on any committee/commission minutes.

(3) That this resolution be placed on the Common Council Agenda as an amendment of a special rule of order, thereby subject to a vote of the majority of the entire Common Council. "
