SUBJECT:

Proposed Department of Public Works Table of Organization modification

related to Utility Locator and Engineering Technician Positions.

The Department of Public Works has pending vacant positions which have provided us an opportunity to review our current organizational structure for providing utility locator and engineering technician services.

## CURRENT STRUCTURE----

As shown on the attached Table of Organization, we currently have 2 part-time (0.67 FTE) Engineering Technicians and 1 full-time (1.0 FTE) Utility Locator. The effort to train Engineering Technicians is significant as their job responsibilities are diverse including construction survey, AutoCAD drafting and construction inspection. Because part-time positions typically tend to have a higher turnover rate, the training efforts are not realized to their full potential.

The Utility Locator's job responsibilities, on the other hand, are very focused on field locating public works sanitary sewer, storm sewer, watermain and lateral infrastructure. The workload for utility locating is significantly higher during the construction season than during the winter season.

The proposed Table of Organization change shifts 0.34 FTE's from the overall pool of Engineering Technicians to the overall pool of Utility Locators as this better reflects the workload and allows us to pay at a more appropriate wage based on that workload.

## PROPOSED STRUCTURE

Based on the above factors, we propose to modify our Table of Organization to have the fulltime position be an Engineering Technician and the 2 part-time (8 month) positions Utility Locators. The anticipated financial implications are as follows:
