Any items still at the curb after 48 hours of this notification will be subject to a minimum \$75.00 collection charge.

Dear City of Appleton Resident:

- Extra garbage that could fit inside your empty City provided cart will only be collected when it is inside your cart or has a special disposal sticker attached to it.** Because garbage cart charges are based on volume, bagged garbage that does not fit in your cart must have a disposal sticker attached. Disposal options include:
 - Remove the garbage from the curb and purchase a \$4.00 sticker for each bag and place on the curb for next week's pickup. Place the sticker on the bag so the sticker is clearly visible to the driver. Please place bags 5 feet away from your cart.
 - Request a larger cart if your household is continually generating more garbage than your cart will hold. A 60 gallon cart costs 50¢ per week and a 90 gallon cart costs \$1.30 per week.
 - Schedule a special garbage collection if you are moving or just cleaning house and have a large amount of garbage. The cost is \$75.00 and must be paid in advance at 2625 E. Glendale Avenue.

- Large waste items are collected every other week, opposite your recycling week.** Large items such as furniture (couch, chair, mattress, table, etc.), carpet, lumber (nails removed or pounded over) and lawn mowers (oil and gas removed) are considered bulky and are picked every other week at no charge. Carpet and lumber must be cut to 4 foot lengths and bundled not to exceed 45 lbs. **Items must be removed from the terrace until the night before your garbage day the week opposite recycling.** Place items 5 feet away from your garbage cart the night before collection opposite your recycling week.

- The City does not collect electronics or hazardous materials.** You may bring electronic devices to the Outagamie County Landfill for proper disposal. Hazardous waste must be disposed of via the County's Clean Sweep program. An appointment is required for hazardous waste. Please call 920-832-5277 ext. 3 or visit www.recyclemoreoutagamie.org for fees and information.

- Brush and yard waste are NOT collected curbside at this time.** You may bring branches and brush free of charge to a City yard site. (Hours are 9 am to 6:45 pm Fri., Sat., Sun., Mon.) **Grass clippings are accepted at the yard sites for \$4.00 a bag.** You also may take your yard waste to the Outagamie County Landfill. (Hours are 7 am to 3:30 pm Mon. thru Fri.) For specific questions, call 832-5580. Any items still at the curb after 48 hours of this notification will be collected for a minimum \$75.00 charge.

- All tires and major appliances require a sticker at all times.** Tire and appliance stickers can be purchased at City Hall (100 N. Appleton St.), Municipal Services Building (2625 E. Glendale Ave.), Kitz & Pfeil, Northside Hardware, Ace Hardware and your nearest Fire Station. Place the sticker where it is visible to the driver. The item will be picked on or after your garbage day. Please place them 5 feet away from your cart the night before your garbage day.
