# **City of Appleton Historic Preservation Commission**

## 2014 HISTORIC PRESERVATION CERTIFICATE AWARDS

2014 marks the 12<sup>th</sup> consecutive year of the City of Appleton Historic Preservation Commission's Historic Preservation Certificate Awards Program. This year one (1) Historic Stewardship Certificate Award will be presented by the Mayor and the Chairperson of Historic Preservation Commission at the May 21, 2014 Common Council meeting. Since the inception of the program, 80 awards have been presented to property owners that recognize their efforts that helped preserve the historic resources of Appleton.

The Historic Preservation/Restoration Award acknowledges projects based upon the following criteria.

## **General Certificate Eligibility:**

- a. The property must be located within the City of Appleton.
- b. The nominated work must have been completed within the past 5 years.
- c. The building/structure must be 50 years or older.
- d. Restoration or revitalization projects must be completed and must have been completed by the current property owner.
- e. If required, the property owner must have obtained required city permits and approvals for the project.
- f. Significant archeological resources affected by a project shall be protected and preserved. If such resources must be disturbed, mitigation measures shall be undertaken.
- g. Preservation Certificates are awarded for work done to the exterior of the building only, and not to any interior restoration or modification.

# **Eligibility for Stewardship Certificate:**

- a. Nominations in this category acknowledge projects in which the exterior character of a building or structure has been maintained, restored or rehabilitated true to the documented, or the reasonably assumed intent of the original historic design.
- b. Stewardship Certificates are awarded for buildings in which the owners have provided on-going care and upkeep which maintains the integrity of the original historical architectural design including detailing and materials within the parameters of the eligibility criteria for a Stewardship Certificate.
- c. Exterior design changes including building additions may have occurred or new materials may have been used, yet the end result needs to respect the integrity of the original historic architecture. For example: the use of modern surfacing and/or trims, replacement windows, replacement doors, etc. provided they are true to the original design of the building/structure.
- d. Paint work and color palette need not match the original to the building but must be consistent with those used at the time period which the historical style of the building represents.
