Applicant's Request: Applicant is requesting to place sculptures associated with Sculpture Valley Season III on City owned properties. Sculptures will be placed for a period of 2 years. Sites have been identified, but the specific works for each site have not been chosen at this point.

BACKGROUND

Per the Art in Public Places Policy, public art projects that are not city-commissioned are initially forwarded to the APAC and the committee determines if the project meets the goals and mission of the APAC. If the committee agrees, the project is forwarded to Community and Economic Development Staff to coordinate review.

Non city-commissioned projects are defined as proposals initiated and funded by an entity other than the City.

RECOMMENDATION
