# 14-1112 Peabody Street, from Verbrick Street to Seymour Street, be reconstructed as follows

-Peabody Street, from Verbrick Street west of Peabody to Verbrick Street east of Peabody, be reconstructed with asphalt pavement and concrete curb and gutter to a width of 33' from back of curb to back of curb, which is the same width as the existing street. New sidewalk-would be constructed to the Right-of-Way line along the west side of this portion of Peabody street.

-Peabody Street, from Verbrick Street to Seymour Street, be reconstructed with asphalt pavement and concrete curb and gutter to a width of 31' from back of curb to back of curb, which is 2' narrower than the existing street.

WHEREAS, the Appleton Common Council has subsequently approved on-street bike lanes on segments of Badger Avenue, Ballard Road, Capitol Drive, College Avenue Bridge, Coop Road, Drew Street, Franklin Street, Fremont Street, Glendale Avenue, Jackman Street, Kensington Drive, Mason Street, Meade Street, Newberry Street, Olde Oneida Street, Oneida Skyline Bridge, Plank Road and South River Street, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that staff be directed to complete retrofit sections of the Bike Lane Plan as follows:

Capitol Drive (Richmond St. to west city limits)

Implement in 2014

Parking removed from both sides

#### Capitol Drive (McDonald St. to 150 feet west of Morrison St.)

Implement in 2015

Parking removed from both sides (150 feet west of Morrison St. to Durkee St.)

Parking removed from one side (Durkee St. to Lawe St.)
Parking removed from both sides (Lawe St. to McDonald St.)

Prospect Avenue (Oneida St. to Mason St.)

Implement concurrent with Prospect Avenue Bridge project (currently planned for 2015)

Parking removed from both sides

#### Roemer Road (Glendale Av. To Capitol Dr.)

Implement concurrent with Glendale Av. Reconstruction project (currently planned for 2015)

Parking removed from one side (Glendale Av. To Winslow Dr.) Parking removed from both sides (Winslow Dr. to Capitol Dr.)

#### N. Oneida Street

Implement in 2015

Parking removed from both sides (Atlantic St. to Winnebago St.)
Parking retained on both sides/sharrows (Winnebago St. to Commercial St.) - widened in the future

Parking removed from both sides (Commercial St. to Northland Av.)

#### Telulah Avenue (Calumet St. to Midway Rd.)

Implement concurrent with reconstruction of Telulah Av. North of Calumet St. (currently planned for 2018)
Parking removed from both sides"
