#### 2. MINUTES OF THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES COMMITTEE

Badger Avenue from Mason Street to Wisconsin Avenue be reconstructed with concrete pavement and curb and gutter to a width of 47' from back of curb to back of curb, which is 2' narrower than the existing street width. The newly reconstructed Badger Avenue would include an 8' parking lane along the north/east side of the street, a 2' buffer area between the parking lane and bike lane, a 5' wide bike lane along the north/east side of the street, two 12.5' travel lanes, and a 6' wide bike lane along the south/west side of the street. Parking would be removed from the south/west side of Badger Avenue within the proposed project limits. New concrete sidewalk would be constructed to the right-of-way line along the property at 1219 Badger Avenue.

Existing sidewalk would be reconstructed to 6' wide directly adjacent to the curb and gutter. Parking would be removed from both sides of Meade Street within the proposed project limits.
