The 2015 CIP budget includes \$75,000 to hire a consultant to conduct ADA Accessibility Audits for our facilities and parks to obtain compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Title II, and the 2010 Standard for Accessible Design to improve the access to municipal facilities, parks and recreation facilities, and enhance amenities for citizens.

Four consultants responded to the Request for Proposal. A team consisting of the Grounds Manager, Parks Planner and Liaison and myself reviewed the proposals and unanimously selected Accessibility Consultation and Training Services (ACT Services, Inc.). Past experience, qualifications of the team performing similar audits, approach and understanding of the project, and references were all considered as essential criteria.

There is an extreme variation in pricing. ACT Services is a widely recognized firm specializing only in ADA audits and is highly respected throughout the industry. Though it can be difficult to understand the variation in pricing, the lower cost proposed by ACT may be a result of their specialization in this area, ability to be extremely efficient due to performing thousands of these type of audits and their ability to maintain a low overhead. They fully meet the requirements of the Request for Proposal and the Americans with Disabilities Act requirements for such an audit.

The 2015 Capital Improvement budget allocated monies to purchase and install new playground equipment at our city parks. After weighing such factors as age, appearance, repair costs, and current trends of play, staff decided to replace the ages 5-12 year-old category play component at Lions Park. The budget allocated \$50,000 for this project. The remainder of the funds will be used for ADA compliant engineered wood mulch surfacing and accessibility walkways.

Four playground equipment firms responded to Requests for Proposals. The firms were judged and graded by the Parks, Recreation and Facilities Management Department's staff. Each firm's designs were graded in the following areas; relevant experience, play value, layout/design and maintenance, overall impression, safety/risk factors, warranty, and cost.

Our staff recommends awarding Team REIL Inc. (Miracle Manufacturing) a contract to provide and install ages 5-12 year old category equipment at Lions Park for a contract total of \$42,256. The final bids were as follows:

- 1. Team REIL Inc. \$42,256
- 2. Miller & Associates \$45,254
- 3. Gerber Leisure Option \$49,930
- 4. Lee Recreation \$50,000
