Resolved,

The 2018 Executive Budget and Service Plan as published in the newspaper and subsequently amended by the Common Council, be adopted as amended. There be levied upon the taxable property of the several wards of the City of Appleton the sum of \$35,646,816 for General Fund purposes;

Be it further resolved.

There be levied upon the taxable property of the several wards of the City of Appleton the sum of \$6,481,724 for Debt Service Funds;

There be levied upon the taxable property of the several wards of the City of Appleton the sum of \$2,044,968 for Special Revenue Funds;

The Department of Finance be authorized to sell general obligation promissory notes and/or bonds in the amount of \$\$36,443,350, including contracting with bond counsel, financial advisors and rating agencies, as necessary. Further, an official statement be prepared and distributed by the Director of Finance in support of the sale.

The Director of Finance be authorized to sell water, sewer, or stormwater revenue supported bonds in the amount of \$11,700,000, including contracting with bond counsel, financial advisors and rating agencies, as necessary. Further, an Official Statement be prepared and distributed by the Director of Finance in support of the sale.

Be it further resolved.

That all projects included herein are not appropriated or authorized to proceed until nontax funding sources are committed without recourse.
