### SANITARY LATÈRALS, STORM LATERALS AND STORM MAIN

### **RESOLUTION 3-P-19**

PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO EXERCISE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT POWERS UNDER SECTION 66.0703 (7) (a), WISCONSIN STATUTES OF 2011-2012.

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Appleton, Wisconsin:

1. The Common Council hereby declares its intention to exercise its powers under Section 66.0703, Wisconsin Statutes, to levy special assessments upon property within the following described area for benefits conferred upon such property by improvement of the following area.

### SANITARY LATERALS, STORM LATERALS AND STORM MAIN

Morrison Street - Hancock Street to Wisconsin Avenue Winnebago Street - Oneida Street to Drew Street Carpenter Street - Taft Avenue to Fremont Street Prospect Avenue - Seminole Road to Haskell Street Opechee Street at Leminwah Henry St - Warner Street to Telulah Avenue Warner St - Henry Street to College Avenue Harriet Street - Walter Avenue to Telulah Avenue Erb St - Michigan Street to 100' N/O Michigan Street Randall St - Oneida Street to Meade Street

- 2. The total amount assessed against such property shall not exceed the total cost of the improvements. The Common Council determines that such improvements shall be made under the police power and the amount assessed against each parcel shall be on a cost per front foot, area or unit cost basis.
- 3. The assessments against any parcel may be paid to the Finance Department on receipt of Special Assessment Notice by one of the following:
  - a. In cash, or if entered on the Tax Roll;
  - b. One installment, if the assessment is \$1000 or less;
  - c. In five equal annual installments, if the assessment is greater than \$1000;

Deferred payments shall bear an interest at the rate of 8.5% per annum on the unpaid balance.

- 4. The Finance Committee is directed to prepare a report consisting of:
  - a. Preliminary plans and specifications for said improvements.
  - b. An estimate of the entire cost of the proposed street improvements.
  - c. A schedule of proposed assessments showing the properties that are benefited by the work or improvements.

Upon completing such report, the Finance Committee is directed to file a copy thereof in the office of the City Clerk for public inspection.

5. Upon receiving the report of the Finance Committee, the City Clerk is directed to give notice of a public hearing on such report as specified in Section 66.0703 (7) (a), Wisconsin Statutes. The hearing shall be held at the Council Chambers in the City Hall at a time set by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 66.0703 (7) (a), Wisconsin Statutes.

Re: Preventing Frozen Sump Pump Lines Property Address: 2323 Roemer Rd, Appleton WI

Dear Resident/Property Owner,

Our records indicate that you may have a private underground plumbing connection from your property to the City storm sewer system. This underground plumbing may be connected to your sump pump, downspouts, yard drain(s) or a hole in the curb that drains into the street. Due to the extreme cold weather our region experiences in the winter, the frost depth may extend down to these underground pipes, causing them to freeze. If this freezing occurs, the water from your property will not properly drain into the City storm sewer in the street.

To prevent this trapped water from entering or damaging your home, you should be prepared to temporarily remove your connection(s) to this underground piping during the winter months to allow your sump pump and downspouts to flow onto your yard and away from your house. In areas with yard drains, please be advised that there may be periods during late winter and early spring when they may not function until they thaw. You can expect some ponding of water in these areas and should take appropriate precautions to protect your property during the time when the drains are out of service.

If you do experience a frozen underground connection or have water entering your home, you may call our Public Works Operations office at 920-832-5580 to ask for assistance with getting the City storm sewer pipe thawed. Depending on our workload and the number of calls we receive, it may take several days to respond and we only offer this service during our regular office hours.

If you have questions about the plumbing needed to allow quick and easy disconnection during the winter months, please call our plumbing inspections office at 920-832-6474.
