RE: Action: Reject bids from Van Ert Electric, Michels Power, and Bodart Electric for the 2019 Pierce Park Lighting Upgrades Project Phase 1.

The 2019 Capital Improvement Plan includes \$125,000 to upgrade the lighting at Pierce Park. This is the first phase of a two-phase project to upgrade the exterior lighting at Pierce Park. Of that amount \$14,450 has been utilized for design leaving a balance of \$110,550 for construction. Bids were opened on August 8, 2019 for the installation of a new electrical service panel, new road lighting, and parking lot lighting.

The bids received were as follows:

Michels Power	\$126,394.95
Van Ert Electric	\$144,263.76
Bodart Electric	\$160,515.00

The bids exceeded our project budget and after conferring with our consulting engineer, the Parks, Recreation and Facilities Management Department is recommending rejecting the bids and deferring this project until 2020.

RE: Action: Award the City of Appleton "2019 Pierce Park Playground Sitework Project" contract to Cardinal Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$250,467.37 with a contingency of \$24,000 for a project total not to exceed \$274,467.37.

Action: Approve balance transfer of \$100,000 from the "2019 Parks Lighting Upgrades Project" to "2019 Pierce Park Playground Sitework Project."

The 2019 Capital Improvement Plan includes \$325,000 to replace the existing playground at Pierce Park. Of that amount \$19,958 has been utilized for design services and \$130,000 has been utilized for playground equipment, leaving a balance of \$175,042 for sitework construction. This project includes removing the old playground, preparing the site for the improvements, concrete surfacing for improved ADA access, and rubber playground surfacing. The playground equipment itself was awarded as part of a separate contract.

The bids were received as follows:

Cardinal Construction (low bid)	\$250,467.37
Highway Landscapers	\$287,941.00
Milbach Construction	\$341,429.51
R & R Wash Materials	\$378,174.50

We are requesting a balance transfer from the Parks Lighting Project. The Parks Lighting Project was deferred to 2020 due to bids coming in over budget and coordination/conflicts with other events occuring in Pierce Park this fall.

Our consulting engineer has written the City of Appleton a formal letter of recommendation to award the contract to Cardinal Construction Co., Inc. The Parks, Recreation, and Facilities Management Department has also reviewed the bids and is in agreement with the engineer's recommendation. Therefore, we recommend awarding the contract to Cardinal Construction Co., Inc in the amount of \$250,467.37 plus a contingency of \$24,000 only to be utilized as needed.

EASEMENT

For good and valuable consideration which LAWRENCE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN, hereinafter referred to as "grantor", owner of land, acknowledges receipt of, grants and warrants to the CITY OF APPLETON, of Outagamie, Calumet and Winnebago Counties, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "grantee", a permanent storm sewer easement upon, within and beneath a part of grantor's land described herein.

See Exhibit "A" for the easement area description, Exhibit "B" for a Map of the easement area and Exhibit "C" for Restoration Terms, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

- 1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this easement is for the Grantee to access, install, regrade, replace, relocate, operate, maintain, resize and repair a storm sewer and associated appurtenances. Trees, bushes, branches and roots may be trimmed or removed so as not to interfere with grantee's use of the easement area.
- 2. Access: Grantee or its agents shall have the right to enter the grantor's land for exercising its rights in the easement area.
- **3.** Buildings or Other Structures: The grantor agrees that no buildings or permanent structures will be erected in the easement area.

- 4. Elevation: The grantor agrees that the elevation of the existing ground surface within the easement area will not be altered by more than 4 inches without the written consent of grantee.
- 5. Restoration: Restoration shall be in conformance with the attached Exhibit "C", Term Sheet for Sewer Easement.
- 6. Notification: Grantee shall provide advance notice to Grantor (except in emergency situations, in which event notice shall be provided as soon as is practical) of any activity with a reasonable likelihood of interfering or disrupting Grantor's operations, and to conduct such activities at mutually agreeable times.
- 7. This grant of easement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs, successors and assigns of all parties hereto.



Non-Binding Term Sheet for Sewer Easement 100 W. Water Street – Lawrence Academy of Music August 1, 2019

Grantor: Lawrence University Grantee: City of Appleton

Overview: Grantee has requested an easement to facilitate connection of storm sewer lateral across Grantor's property at 100 W. Water Street. Said project will require disruption of Grantor's business activities on the property as well as destruction of existing sidewalks and parking facilities. Grantee has requested an expedited approval process from Grantor given an unanticipated issue with the project as originally planned.

Obligations of Grantor: Provide an easement granting permanent right-of-way for below-grade sewer infrastructure to be installed, owned, operated, and maintained by the Grantee. In the interest of expedience, Grantor waives appraisal of the easement value. Grantor will bear one third of the cost for the resurfacing, sealing, and striping of the entire existing parking lot. Grantor will be responsible for ongoing maintenance of the University-owned parking lot and sidewalks on the property following completion of the project.

Obligations of Grantee: Plan, install, operate, and maintain below-grade sewer infrastructure in the easement area provided by the Grantor. Grantee will replace in-kind any concrete sidewalks, curb, and gutter damaged as a result of the project. Additionally, in lieu of payment for this easement, and reflecting the anticipated damage to Grantor's parking facilities, Grantee will arrange for and carry out the resurfacing, sealing, and striping of the entire existing parking lot and bear two thirds of the final cost of that project. Grantee will draft easement documents for Grantor signature. Grantee will record easement documents with Outagamie County.

The 2019 Capital Improvement Plan includes \$85,000 for safety and security improvements to parks. This includes installation of fiber to the Scheig Center to allow security camera connection and card access installation. In addition, it will allow future computer network access and building automation controls for HVAC equipment. Furthermore, due to the proximity of the Appleton Memorial Park Jones Building, accommodations will be made at this time to allow future fiber installation at the Appleton Memorial Park Jones Building.

This memo is a request to sole source a contract to Holtger Bros., Inc. for installation of fiber to the Scheig Center located within Appleton Memorial Park. Holtger Bros., Inc. has been sole sourced for fiber work for City of Appleton properties previously and has extensive knowledge and experience of the Appleton Area Metropolitan Fiber Optic Network (AAMFON).

It is the recommendation of the Parks, Recreation & Facilities Management Department to execute a contract with Holtger Bros., Inc. in the amount of \$36,840 with a contingency of \$3,800 for a project total not to exceed \$40,640.
