










There were 22 comments from citizens of the City of Appleton that came forward to express their opinions on this redevelopment. The following is their responses:




Preferred Concept


There were two different concepts presented at the meeting, each providing various options in utilizing the Memorial Park area. Of the two options, Concept #2 was the most widely accepted, receiving 4 of the 22 votes. Of the 22 people that filled out the comment cards, 17 did not respond directly in favor of one concept over the other, but had insight to the details of the plan.

Amphitheater Location

There were **9** comments regarding the location of the amphitheater. 5 people liked the idea of the amphitheater being close to the Scheig building (as in concept plan #1). 4 people liked the amphitheater's location in concept plan #2. There were 13 people that did not voice an opinion on the matter.



Walking Trails Of the 22 comments on the renovations, 8 people liked the walking trail plan. The other 14 people did not voice an opinion on this topic. 3 people also said that they would like to see distance markers on the walking trails to tell how far they have walked and/or how far they have left to walk.



• Preference for the Northwest Corner of the Park

Of the 22 comments on the renovations, 11 people wanted to see the northwest corner of the park being left alone. They wanted the wooded area to be persevered and no activities added to this area. There were 11 people that did not voice an opinion on the matter.

Common General Suggestions for Memorial Park

- •Add at least 4 tennis courts to the park (2)
- •Fence in the play areas (1)
- •Don't include the rope course-too dangerous, liability issues (2)
- •Install more colorful wildflowers on North Berm (2)
- •Make a continuous trail around perimeter (2)
- Add distance markers to walking trails (3)
- •Enough restrooms? (2)
- •Preserve the gardens (2)
- Concerns about skiing trail (1)
 - •Groomed?
 - •Skiing and snowshoeing?
