REASONS FOR INTENDED ACTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.12(3) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES.

The Appleton Police Department intends to ask for such a recommendation for the following reasons:

On September 30, 2013, the Appleton Police Department arrested Shanna McKeefry for the following: Resisting/ obstructing an officer, Encouraging a parole/ probation violation, Possessing an illegally obtained prescription, and Possessing drug paraphernalia. Ms. McKeefry was subsequently convicted of all of the aforementioned offenses on or about June 4, 2014.

RECOMMENDATION

The most recent incident clearly shows that the defendant, Shanna McKeefry, has engaged in illegal conduct substantially related to the licensed activity and that she does not possess the qualifications required under Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes to hold said license. In light of the seriousness of these violations, the Appleton Police Department is asking this committee not to renew Shanna McKeefry operator's license.
