We are pleased to submit our proposal for the Column Repair project located in Appleton, Wisconsin.

The following items are included in our proposal:

- Upon onsite evaluation of the 2 columns in question we feel the following repairs need to be completed: Masonry removed from around the structural steel. Structural steel columns need to be cleaned of rust, primed and painted. Column to beam connections need to be cleaned of rust, installation of new gusset plates to help support the beams, and painted.
