Subject: Exercising second option year with New Hope Center for Specialized Transportation Services in 2016

The New Hope Center specialized transportation service is a shared ride service in Calumet County which brings employees to and from the New Hope Center located in Chilton, Wisconsin. Valley Transit has had an agreement with New Hope Center in Calumet County since 2003 to provide this service. The current contract is a three year contract which was approved by the Transit Commission on May 23, 2012, and commenced on July 1, 2012, with options to extend by mutual consent for two one-year periods. The original three year contract term concluded on June 30th, 2015, with New Hope Center in Calumet County exercising its first option year which will end on June 30th, 2016.

Valley Transit and New Hope Center have agreed to exercise the second option year at the current price of \$2.11/mile. New Hope Center will continue providing specialized transportation services in Calumet County through June 30th, 2017.
