The next meeting of the City's Tax Payment Timeliness Appeal Board is March 15, 2017 at City Center, 100 N. Appleton Street, 6th Floor, Committee Room D. You are invited to attend at 6:45 PM. If that date conflicts with your schedule, please contact me so that we may arrange another. There is no requirement for you to attend, but we want to insure the process is open to all interested parties.

Chapter 74 of the State Statutes defines the tax collection procedures for all municipalities in Wisconsin. The Board only has the authority to overturn late payments when the payment is delinquent due to a postal delay or error (ie. letters mailed after 7:00 pm are dated the next day, mail is not picked up during a snow storm, or a check is lost in the mail (in that case, there is a form at the post office to be filled out)). The Board does not have the authority for the following reasons:

- Forgot but had g
- Many years as a
- Illness, divorce,
