Rules of Conduct

Policy

Everyone has the right to use the Appleton Public Library without being disturbed by others. Disruptive, unsafe, illegal or damaging behavior is not allowed.

RESPECT OTHERS

- Loud and disruptive behavior, verbal or physical harassment, intoxication, running, fighting, or similar behaviors are not allowed.
- There is zero tolerance for threats and acts of violence.
- Staring at or following others with the intent to annoy or harass is not allowed.
- Eavesdropping on library users or staff is an invasion of privacy and is not allowed.
- Sleeping is not allowed.
- Panhandling, distributing, or selling non-library approved materials without permission is not allowed.
- Persons whose bodily hygiene is an offensive nuisance to other library users will be asked to leave
- Using another person's card without permission to check out materials is not allowed. Using another
 person's card to use Internet computers is never allowed. Misrepresentation of identity or eligibility for
 services may be prosecuted as a felony.

RESPECT YOUR SURROUNDINGS

- Damaging or tampering with Library property is not allowed.
- Roller-skating, roller-blading, and skateboarding are not allowed.
- Use of tobacco products is not allowed in adherence to Library Smoking and Tobacco Use Policy.
- Bathing, shaving or washing clothing is not allowed.
- Furniture is limited to the number of people and the use it was designed for. Furniture cannot be moved without permission.
- Doors, aisles and stairs must remain unblocked.
- Clean up after yourself. Dispose of food and drink properly.
- Patrons are not allowed in staff areas.

REMEMBER

- Possession or use of alcohol or illegal drugs is not allowed.
- Breaking the law or city ordinance is not allowed. Violators will be prosecuted.
- Weapons of any kind, including concealed or openly visible firearms, are not allowed unless carried by an authorized law enforcement agent.
- You must check out materials before stepping past security gates.
- Bicycles and scooters must be parked in the outside bike racks.
- Patrons must wear shoes and be fully clothed.
- Cell phone conversations are allowed only on the Library's first floor and lower level. All conversations must be kept at a volume that is courteous to others.
- Parents and caregivers are responsible for the behavior and supervision of their children in compliance with the Unattended Children Policy.
- Animals are not allowed in the library, except for service animals accompanying persons with disabilities.
- The Library reserves the right to inspect bags, briefcases, backpacks or other personal items.
- Library staff has the right to request proof of identification including library card or other ID.
- Personal items cannot be left unattended. The Library has no responsibility for such items.
- Staff will contact the police about suspicious or abandoned property.

Failure to follow these rules will result in discipline up to and including loss of Library privileges.
