Here is the list of buildings that Wallace W. DeLong designed in Appleton that I know of. When I started my research, the Wisconsin Historical Society only credited him with 3 or 4 buildings in Appleton. As you can see, they now credited him with many more. I'm sure he designed a whole lot more that what I was able to find. I was only able to discover buildings that were written about in the local newspaper or in a trade journal. I'm sure most houses that were built never made it into either publication. Also, notice how many of his buildings have been demolished. It's very unfortunate. In the other cities where his buildings are, by far most of them are still standing. Therefore when I write my article about him, I will probably highlight more buildings outside of Appleton than in Appleton, even though he was an Appleton architect.

If I come across any more Appleton buildings designed by DeLong, I'll let you know.
