Whereas the R3 and CBD zoning of the 200 block of North Fair Street does not reflect the present usage of the properties along this street Whereas the zoning of the properties of the 200 block of North Fair Street was done by the City in 1994, likely in hope that it would generate future development reflective of the zoning Whereas no development on this block has taken place since the rezoning and those who own houses on this block, along with their alderperson, are not aware of any possible development pending in the near future

Whereas the property owners on the 200 block of North Fair Street desire that their properties be properly zoned according to their usage Therefore, be it resolved, that the zoning of the properties in the 200 block of North Fair Street reflect the present usage of said properties. Be it further resolved, that the Community & Economic Development Department identify other areas similar to the 200 block of North Fair Street, as it pertains to zoning, and if it is the desire of the property owners, properly zone these properties according to their usage.
