The Board of Health for the City of Appleton hereby **UPHOLDS** Humane Officer Fillebrown's determination of the Respondent's dogs, Buddy Boy and Angie, as Dangerous Animals under Sec. 3-131 of the Municipal Code of the City of Appleton, while **granting a conditional partial waiver of certain leash and muzzle and confinement requirements** as described below. All other requirements of Sec. 3-132(a) through (g) of the Municipal Code of the City of Appleton remain in full force.

The leash and muzzle requirements under Sec. 3-132(c)(1) and (4) and the confinement requirements under Sec. 3-132(d)(1) and (2) do not apply when the animals are contained within a fenced enclosure on the premises of the owner's dwelling. The fenced enclosure must be at least six feet tall, properly and lawfully installed, maintained, secured and locked so as to prevent any persons or domestic animals from entering or exiting the enclosure without permission of the owners. At all places and times where these conditions are not met, the leash and muzzle requirements contained in Sec. 3-132(c)(1) and (4) and the confinement requirements contained in Sec. 3-132(d)(1) and (2) shall remain in full effect.

If the Owner further contests this determination, the Owner may seek review of the Board of Health's decision by the Circuit Court within five (5) days of receiving this decision.
