Saturday, August 1, music goes until 11 p.m. Requesting alcohol sales until 10:45 p.m.
Sunday, August 2, music goes until 5 p.m.

Jones Park:

Thursday, July 30, music goes until 10:30 p.m. Requesting alcohol sales until 10:15 p.m.
Friday, July 31, music goes until 10:30 p.m. Requesting alcohol sales until 10:15 p.m.
Saturday, August 1, music goes until 10:30 p.m. Requesting alcohol sales until 10:15 p.m.
Sunday, August 2, there is no music in Jones Park on Sunday.

Through emails on June 17 with Sgt. Biese, APD, he has given his approval with the understanding that all the rules will be followed.

We put up a fair amount of signage in each of these locations (see sample below) and we also let people know they cannot leave the parks with alcohol. In addition, we have experienced managers for each site, and all venue managers and volunteers will notify attendees of park hours each day of the event.
