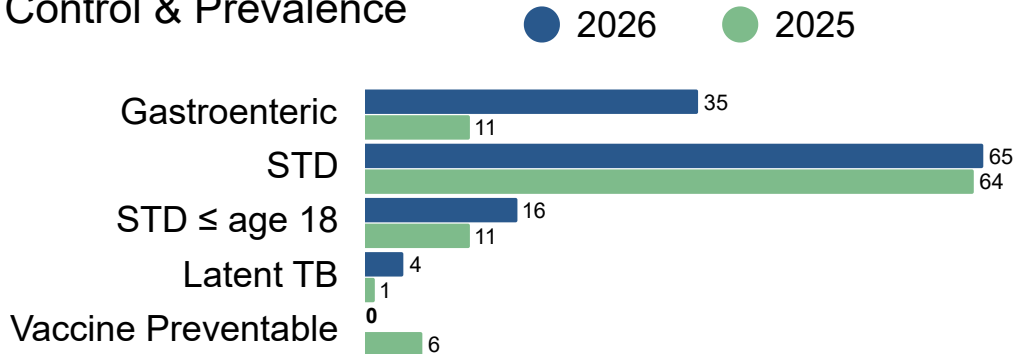

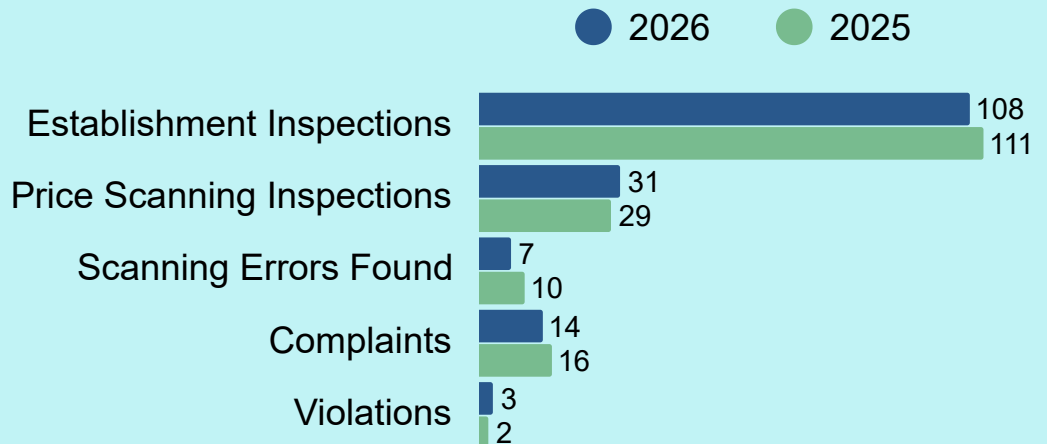

### Communicable Disease Control & Prevalence

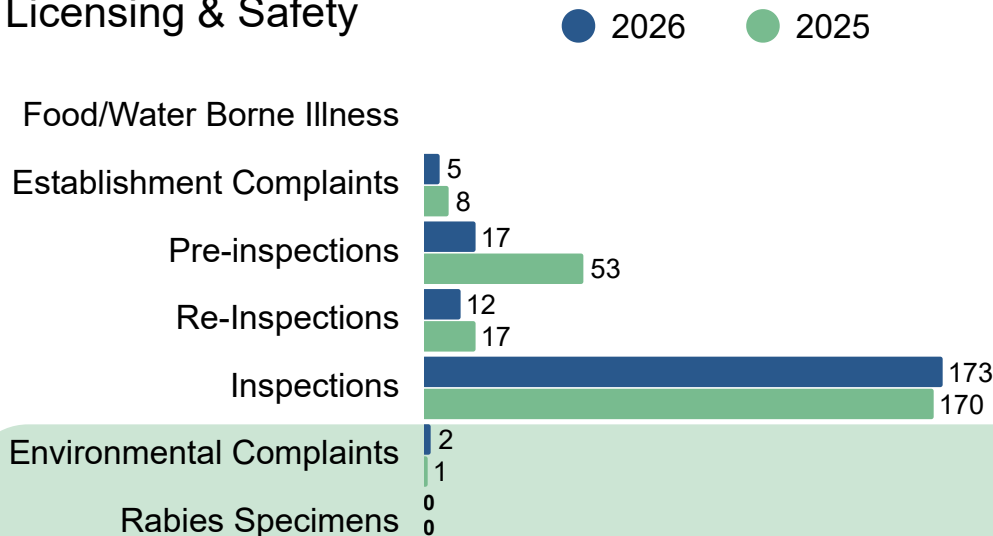


Prevent gastroenteric illness. Wash hands with soap and water before and after eating, drinking, and preparing food and after using the restroom or assisting others with hygiene.
